

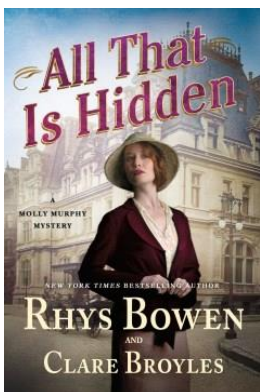

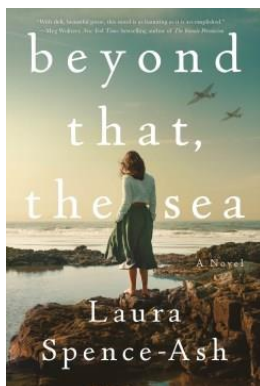

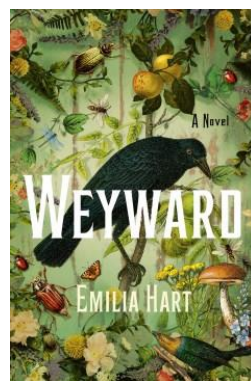
All That Is Hidden

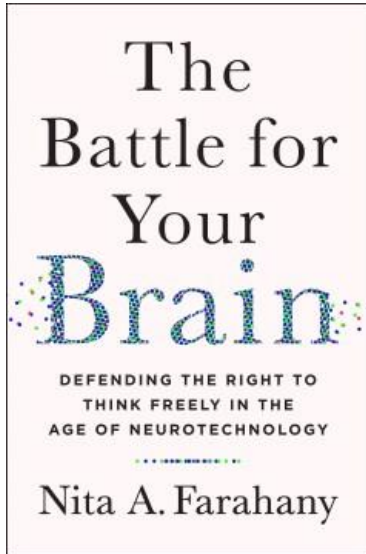

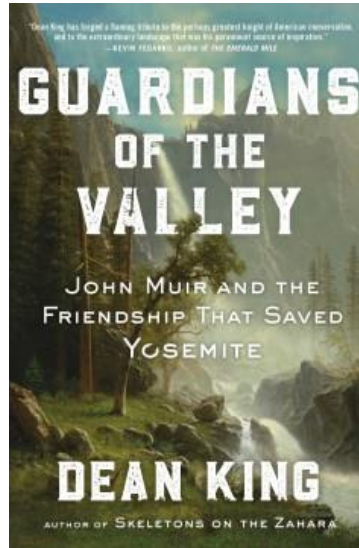
